For budgets around:

- 1,1M€ / hour for primetime drama.
- 1,4M€ / hour for TV movies
- 350K€ / hour for soaps & ½ hr shows
- 400K€ / hour for shortcoms

Between 2013 and 2015, there were 78 series produced, representing 433 episodes.

Most prime-time series are a 6 episodes order.

It goes from 3 hours mini-series (Arte) up to 10 hours series (Canal+)

A few years ago, our main private broadcaster TF1 started to commission series ordering the pilot and episode 2. They would test their audience on a 2 episodes event night, before considering greenlighting the production of the whole series... or axing the series.

In 2015, 2 series got **more than 4M€** from international funding: Versailles & Midnight Sun.

MOVIES BUSINESS

300 movies got the CNC agreement (234 predominantly French) (+15%)

Of those 234, 142 are international coproductions (+40%)

Production medium budget is up to 4,4M€.


